### Planning your quiz

We recommend that you either email your friends or create a Facebook event where you'll be able to invite your friends to participate in the quiz. Ask your friends to send the invite on to their own networks.

You could ask each team for a £5/€5 donation. You can very easily set up a fundraiser for Christian Aid on JustGiving, which will allow you to track how much money you've raised. Simply use the JustGiving links below and create an event under the Christian Aid Week campaign. If you need any help with this please contact us and we will give guidance. You can then ask participants to give online directly through your JustGiving event page.

## Running your quiz

There are two easy options to run your quiz:

### Against the clock

You can post the quiz questions at a set time (eg, 8pm) and give your participants time to tackle the quiz. We recommend 30 to 45 minutes.




You can then post the answers and let the quizzers score themselves, and ask them to share their results and comments as they go along in the event chat. This is the simplest option and should be easy to do.

### Online Platforms

You can go live on online platforms like Zoom, Facebook Live or WhatsApp calling if its a smaller group. This allows you to, speak directly to your audience and personally lead your quiz, reading out the questions as you go along.

If you are using Zoom, you will need to create a meeting and forward the meeting ID and password to all participants ahead of the scheduled quiz. To go live from Facebook, go to your event page and simply click the ‘Live Video’ option to stream to your event participants.



## Our top tips for a live event are:

- Make sure to write the time of your quiz in the event details, so people know when you're going live.
- Post a video beforehand to build some excitement ahead of the event and share your plans. You could share why you've chosen to hold a fundraiser for Christian Aid.
