Creative prayer ideas

Finding Ethiopia

Bring along a world map or globe to share with your prayer group. Point to where Ethiopia is on the map, and ask people to draw a rough outline of it on a piece of paper.

Ethiopia has one of the world's fastest-growing populations and is the second most populous country in Africa.

Write a prayer of thanksgiving, in the outline map of Ethiopia, for one of the things Christian Aid partners are helping communities with there:

- growing food
- getting access to health care
- campaigning for a good government
- working for fair trade and economic justice
- using sustainable and clean energy solutions
- empowering women to stand together for change.

Take a moment to silently pray for our partners to be encouraged, sustained and to have enough resources to do their incredible work.



Healing leaves

Provide a bowl of autumn leaves, some glue, and an outline of a tree trunk and branches on a large piece of paper.

Aberash takes strength from being a part of a women's group. But she didn't always feel this way. 'In the past, there were so many challenges,' she says. 'It was hard to feed my children. Sometimes we ate the leaves of trees during the hard times.'

'The leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations.' Revelations 22:2

Take a leaf and stick it on the tree, as you do so pray for Aberash and all the mothers in Ethiopia and locally who have struggled to feed their children. Pray for justice so that one day we will live in a world where no one goes hungry. Give thanks for the healing the community is bringing to Aberash and her sisters. Pray that we would all continue to stand together, as strong as trees, to work for change.



Creative prayer ideas

Survival tool

Provide blankets and/or survival bags.

Wrap a blanket or survival bag around you as you read these words from Ari, who is a member of one of the women's groups in Ethiopia.

'As a survival tool we pray together, us women and those of us in the church, we live for one another. If one of them is sick, we as members will help them and each other. The problem of one member is the problem of us all and we are going to solve that problem together.'

Give thanks for how the women's groups in Ethiopia gather around each other, wrapping each other in support and care. Give thanks for all those who surround you, looking out for and helping you. And consider who you might surround and help in your community. Give thanks for the survival tool of prayer. Pour out your own heart to God in prayer, knowing you are surrounded by the love of God, like a blanket.



The power of the sun

Preparation: Prepare a selection of sunglasses and sunscreen.

Put on a pair of the sunglasses and rub a little sunscreen into the back of your hands. Imagine the brightness and heat of the sun. This may take some imagination!

Give thanks to God for the incredible power of the sun. For it's reliable presence even when we can't always see or feel it.

Give thanks for how the power of the sun has empowered women in Ethiopia to open a solarpowered shop and has provided solar light for their children to do their homework.

Give thanks for the Christian Aid Breaking the Barriers programme in Ethiopia, Burkina Faso, Malawi and Honduras and how it is empowering communities to stand up to climate change.
